1st Sgt. Basil R. Slaughter retired, age 92, of Henderson, KY. died at 11:50 PM, Monday, August 10, 2009, at Methodist Hospital, Henderson, KY.

He was the son of the late Mary Watkins Slaughter and Holbert R. "Happy" Slaughter.

He was preceded in death by his first wife Louise Kloke Slaughter in 1988.

Sgt. Slaughter was a decorated veteran of World War II and the Korean Conflict. He served in several theatres of war, the most notable being with General George S. Patton's 3rd Army. Recently Sgt. Slaughter stated, "I was out front with Patton all the way."

He worked for Big Rivers for over 15 years. He was an avid hunter, fisherman and lodgeman, having been a loyal member of the Royal Order of the Moose.
