Beatrice "Bea" Raber Goldsberry, age 88, of Henderson, KY, passed away on Thursday, June 12, 2025, at 8:53 a.m. at Redbanks Nursing Home in Henderson.

Beatrice better known as Bea to her family and friends was a faithful member of Zion Baptist Church. She was a quality control secretary for Firestone Steel Company, which is known now as Accuride Corporation.
