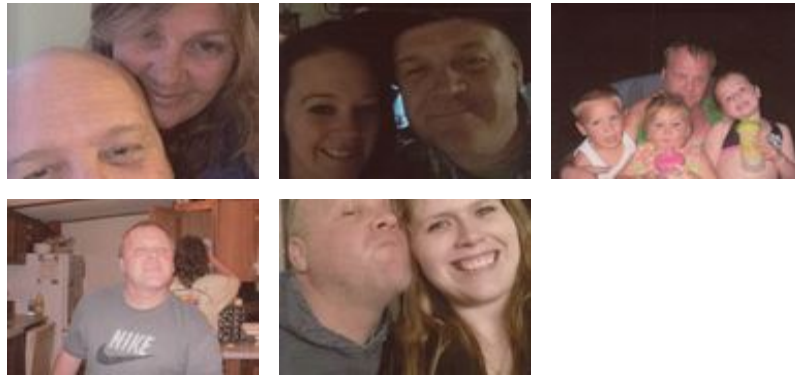

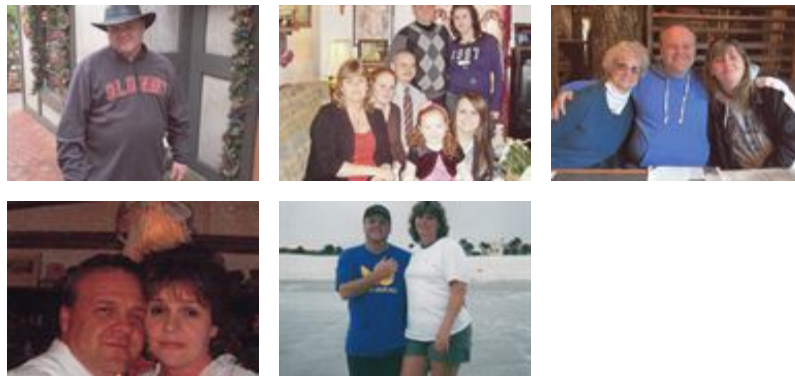


“ Dad,
