CW4 John A. Womack, age 74, was born in Henderson, KY on October 9, 1947 and passed away on March 29, 2022 at Murray Calloway County Hospital in Murray, KY.

John proudly served his country in the United States Army for 28 years. He served from 1990-1991 in Operation Desert Storm Gulf War. 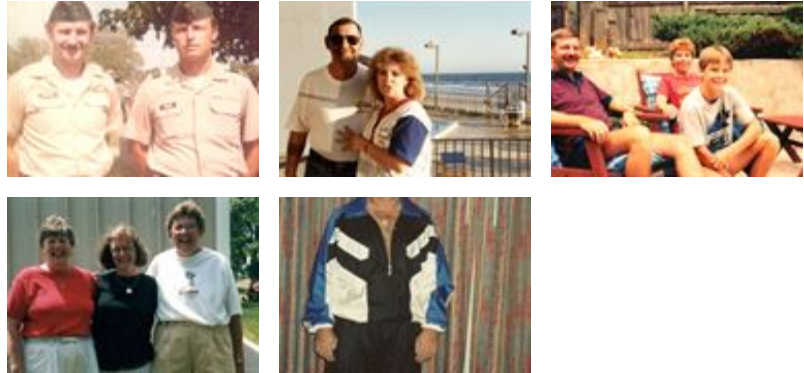

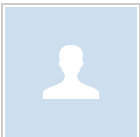
