Dorothy Louise Slaughter Springer, age 93, of Henderson, KY, died peacefully at her home on Wednesday, December 2, 2020 with her daughter by her side. 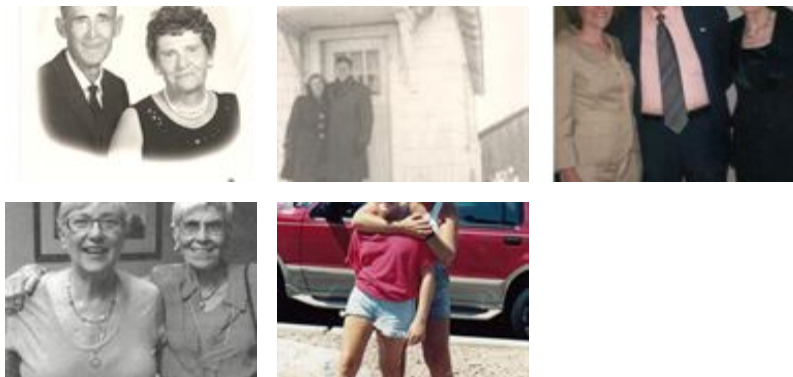
