



## Edmund Kelly Mulligan

July 30, 1921 - June 4, 2015

Edmund Kelly Mulligan, age 93, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 8:15 PM, Thursday, June 4, 2015, at Methodist Hospital in Henderson.

Edmund joined the US Army in November 1942, attained the rank of Staff Sergeant, and served with the 10th Armored Division. He was also a member of a special operations group known as the "Ghost Division". His unit fought in the Ardennes, the Rhineland and in the Battle of the Bulge, defending the city of Bastogne. He was awarded a Purple Heart.

Edmund retired from working as a letter carrier with the US Postal Service. He was an avid fisherman and hunter and especially enjoyed the KY Lakes area.

Edmund was preceded in death by his parents, Dennis and Lina Mulligan, his loving wife of 73 years just this past May 14th, Martha Clay Mulligan, daughter, Linda C. Mulligan in 2013, and brother, Charlie Mulligan.
