Emogene Russell, age 85, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 6:35 PM, Sunday, August 4, 2013, at Redbanks Nursing Home.

Emogene was born December 12, 1927 to John L. and AnnaMae Gaines in the Geneva/Smith Mills area. Her mother passed away when she was 8 years old and she went to live with her brother and his wife, Clifford and Kacky Gaines. She met the love of her life, Marcell, who was a farmer, and married in June of 1944 at age 16. She mostly spent time taking care of the farm, even cooking for all the farm hands. Around 1964 she worked at W.T. Grant, which became Ben Franklin, working mostly with floral arrangements and talking to "everybody". Mrs. Russell was a member at Geneva United Methodist Church where she sang in the choir. When Marcell retired, they moved to Little Dixie and joined Little Dixie United Methodist Church. In her retirement, she loved to go to senior dances with some of her family. She met and made new friends from all over western Kentucky, southern Illinois, and Indiana.

In addition to her parents, Emogene was preceded in death by her loving husband of 49 years, Everett Marcell Russell. She was also preceded by 4 sisters, Margaret Latta, Dorothy Smith, Drusie Beck, and Sadie Sauer; 4 brothers, Clifford Gaines, John Ralph Gaines, Woodrow Gaines, and Joseph

Gaines; and grandson Michael Russell.
