Gary Stephen Rust, age 68, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 5:05 AM, Friday, November 15, 2013, at his home under the care of St. Anthony's Hospice.

Mr. Rust was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Modest Rust and a sister, Patsy Higginson.

After graduating from City High in 1963, Gary went to Murray State University where he earned his Bachelor's degree in Social Studies. He furthered his schooling still, and received two Master's degrees in History and Education. Gary enjoyed a fulfilling career doing what he loved; teaching children. He did his student teaching at Henderson County High School. He taught at Union County High School and North Middle School. He was vice-principal at North Middle School, and principal at Corydon Elementary School, Hebbardsville Elementary School, and then retired from the school system after his final position as principal at East Heights Elementary School. After retiring from his career in education, he was Executive Director of "The Gathering Place" for 14 years. He loved everyone there and never met a stranger.

Gary loved the outdoors. He especially loved hunting and fishing locally, as well as traveling to Texas, Arkansas and Canada on trips with his friends and family. He was named Western District Man of the Year in 1986 by the KY Bowhunter's Association. He was a Master Hunter Educator Instructor for 25 years.

Gary Rust was a caring, loyal, honest, faithful and hardworking man who

loved his family above all else.
