George W. Haag, age 93, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 5:15am, Sunday, September 1, 2013, at the Western Kentucky Veteran's Center in Hanson, KY.

George W. Haag, son of John Adam and Agnes Haag, was born in Greentown, PA on August 15, 1920. He attended Rider University in Trenton, New Jersey earning his Bachelor's Degree in Accounting. He served in the United States Army for three and a half years during WW II, including one year as a Lieutenant (Medical Administrative Officer) in Palm Springs and Menlo Park, CA. Thereafter, he lived in New Jersey and worked in New York City over a 30 year period where he was the Vice President of sales for the US Market for Swedish, Swiss and Israeli manufacturing organizations. He was also the regional manager for the Better Business Bureau.

George was a member of First Baptist Church in Henderson, KY and enjoyed attending Bible study with The Silvertones and fellowship at the Men's Breakfasts. He loved to travel and was blessed to enjoy many trips abroad. He joined the Rotary Club in Palm Springs, CA in 1985 and remained an active Rotarian after moving to Henderson. He felt it was important to keep up with the news and stayed tuned in to his favorite station, The Fox News Channel.
