sportscaster for KOA-TV. From there he moved to WGN in Chicago, IL where he had a 20 year broadcasting career. He was the Black Hawk Hockey announcer and Chicago Bulls and Bears announcer. The Highlights of his broadcasting career includes an Emmy nomination with CBS in Weather Broadcasting.
