Giman Davis Hall, age 90, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 4:46 AM, Tuesday, January 8, 2013, at Western Kentucky Veterans Center, Hanson, KY.

He worked at the Gleaner from 1942 to 1944, then served in the United States Navy from 1944-1946. Mr. Hall then returned to the Gleaner, and eventually retired from Evansville Printing Corp. Gimán was a member of First Baptist Church.
