Henrietta Priest Culver, age 89, passed away Friday afternoon, February 20, 2009 at Redbanks Nursing Home in Henderson, KY. She was born to the late George F. and Annie Denton Priest on October 21, 1919.

She was a member of First Baptist Church, where she had been a member of the Mizpah Sunday School Class and Silvertones. Henrietta was civilian personnel Director at Camp Breckenridge when it closed as an Army Base. She retired as an orientation officer at the Job Corps in 1982 and increased her volunteering at Methodist Hospital, where she was a member of the Auxiliary. She received a 5,500 hour pin in 1994. She was very active in the Henderson Business and Professional Women's Club, serving in many offices. She was named the Business Woman of the year in 1962. She was a past President of the KY Federation of Business and Professional Women's Club and past President of the local club. She was a member of the Hebbardsville Homemakers Club. During her retirement year, she loved her hobbies of sewing and needlepoint. She was an avid KY Wildcat Basketball fan.
