Ira Wayne Williams, age 88, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 7:45 a.m., Saturday, January 5, 2013 at his home.

He received the Europe-Africa-Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon with 3 Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal and WWII Victory Medal. He spent 36 years working as a roughneck in oil field production. Mr. Williams was of the Baptist faith.
