James A. "Jimmy" Newman, age 94, of Henderson, KY, passed away Thursday October 8, 2015.

He served in the Navy during WWII. In addition to working at Taylor Brothers for 10 years, he also served 8 terms as Property Valuation Administrator for Henderson County and City.
