James A. "Lump" Shiver, age 62, of Henderson, KY, passed away, Tuesday, February 4, 2014, at St. Anthony's Lucy Smith King Care Center, in the room sponsored by Home Oil & Gas surrounded by his family.

Jim was raised on the family farm in Hebbardsville, KY when life was simple and carefree. As a child, he spent many hours in the woods playing with his siblings and enjoying the outdoors. He often shared fond memories of childhood games such as stick pony and baseball with tobacco sticks. He was the youngest of 4 children to parents Robert and Mary Shiver. Jim lost his dad at the age of 5, from injuries he sustained while serving in WWII. His mother held a special place of honor in his life, having raised 4 children under the age of 9 while working in the cafeteria at Hebbardsville Elementary School. Jim graduated in 1969 from Henderson County High School and worked for Palmer Oil Company during the summers. In 1974, he went to work for Second and Green Conoco and ran the station for many years. In 1990, the business was operated as Home Oil & Gas. Jim had continued to work for Home Oil & Gas as a driver delivering oil to the surrounding tri-state area. His work ethic was important to him and he was very proud that he had not missed a day of work in 26 years. In 1995, he married his wife Barbara in Panama City Beach, Florida. He loved the ocean and his favorite vacations were relaxing by the beach. Jim enjoyed deer, squirrel, and rabbit hunting. Many hours were spent rabbit hunting with friends, Robbie, and his beagles. He also enjoyed planting his garden every spring. Spring was his favorite

season but he loved celebrating Christmas with his family. Jim's favorite family tradition was fried oysters on Christmas morning. Jim was strong in stature as well as in conviction. He was known for being very witty and had a great sense of humor.
