John was a hard worker and enjoyed swimming in the family pool. He dedicated his time on Sunday to be with family.

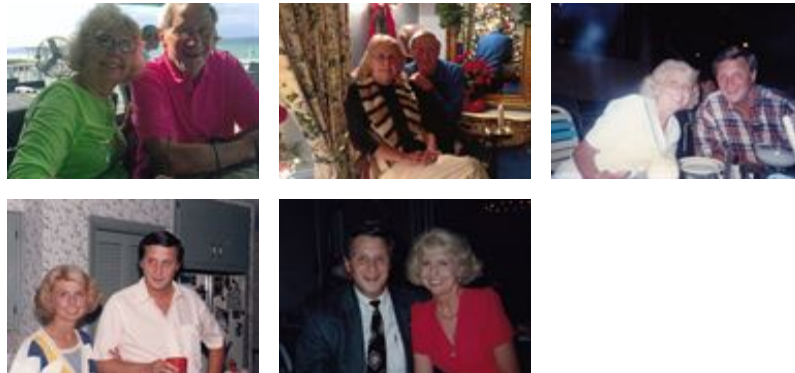
