Joyce Townsend Wilson, age 71, of Henderson, KY, entered into her heavenly home at 1:04 p.m. Friday, May 3, 2019 at Henderson Nursing and Rehabilitation Center under the care of St. Anthony's Hospice.

She was preceded in death by her father, Lilburn Townsend, in 1960, her stepfather, Lloyd Carter, in 1996, and her mother, Ilyene Townsend Carter in 2015.

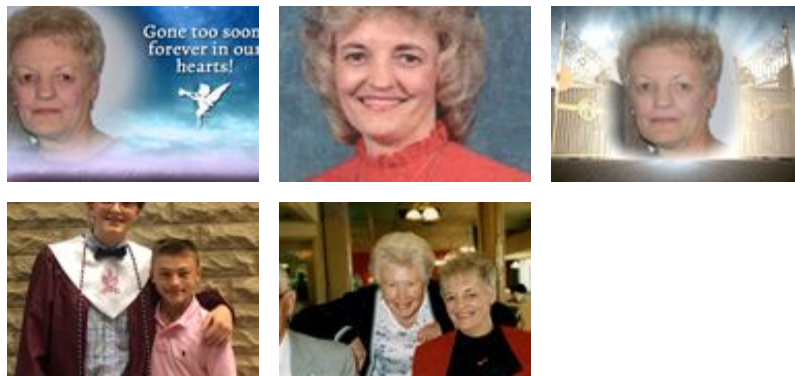
