Kenneth E. "Gene" Scott, age 86, of Owensboro, KY, passed away at 2:30 AM, Friday, February 12, 2016, at his home.

Kenneth was a member of Beals Pentecostal Church in Beals, KY for over 60 years. His favorite past time was wood working. Furniture and toys for the kids were among his favorite crafts. 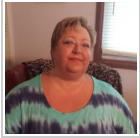
