



## Margie H. Campbell

August 18, 1923 - June 25, 2014

Margie H. Campbell, age 90, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 1:40 PM, Wednesday, June 25, 2014, at St. Anthony's Lucy Smith King Care Center, Henderson, KY.

Margie was born in Evansville, IN, where her father worked at the Chrysler Plant. She graduated from PeeWee Valley High School and earned her Associates Degree in Nursing from Florida Hospital in Orlando, FL. In 1946 Margie met the love of her life, Elvis Campbell. They married on March 5, 1950 and moved to Henderson, KY. Margie worked in the OBGYN department at Methodist Hospital through the 1950's and 1960's. In 1962 Elvis opened the local Campbell Jewelry Store; Margie joined Elvis in the family business in the early 1970's. She continued working at the jewelry store until she was about 87 years old. Together with Elvis, they traveled all over the world. Margie was a longtime member of Henderson Seventh-day Adventist Church, where she was very active and served as a Deaconess. Margie will be missed by many and always be remembered by her loved ones as "just a grand lady, who never met anyone she didn't like".

She was preceded in death by her loving husband Elvis Campbell, parents Otis and Emma Jane Harrelson and brother Amos Harrelson.

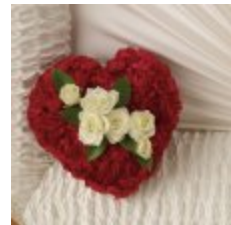
