Martha Hager Thompson Wilson, age 75, went to her eternal home at 4:15am, Saturday, January 11, 2014 at Henderson Nursing and Rehab under the care of St. Anthony's Hospice. Martha was born March 9, 1938 to Robert W. and Lucy (McHargue) Hager, who preceded her in death.

Martha graduated from Holy Name High School in 1956. She enjoyed a fulfilling 18-year career at Community Methodist Hospital as Patient Accounts Manager. She retired in 1997. 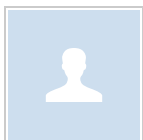
