



## Norman K. "Bud" Kirsch

April 4, 1927 - November 6, 2014

Norman K. "Bud" Kirsch, age 87, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 2:26 PM, Thursday, November 6, 2014, at St. Anthony's Lucy Smith King Care Center.

Bud was a Kentucky native, born in Madisonville. He grew up on his family's farm in Anton, KY. He graduated from Anton High School where he played on the basketball team. After graduation Bud joined the US Navy. Upon returning from his service, he started working for Stremming Veneer based in Evansville, IN. There Bud was responsible for the delivery and pick up of materials. These deliveries had him traveling as far as Maplesville, AL. While in Maplesville on one of these trips he was introduced to his future wife, Elizabeth. They wed on October 7, 1950 at Trinity Lutheran Church and started their life together in Henderson, KY. He later worked at Spencer Chemical and National Southwire as maintenance supervisor.

Bud was a lifelong active member at Trinity Lutheran Church. He loved hunting, fishing, and raising a vegetable garden. Bud was an avid UK Basketball fan. Most of all Bud loved taking care of his Elizabeth, and his whole family.
