Nova Bertha Bradley passed away after a long battle with Alzheimer's at Redbanks Nursing Home, Henderson, Kentucky. Nova was 102 years old.

Nova was born and raised in Ada, Oklahoma. It was there she met and married her husband, Pink James Bradley. In the late 1930's, the couple moved to Smith Mills, Kentucky. During this time, Nova became one of the first women to drive a Henderson County School bus. Many of her riders remember those days and even now still talk about their rides on her bus. Nova drove students on many "Senior Trips" as to Mammoth Cave, Look Out Mountain and other destinations.

In 1968, Nova & Pink moved to Andrews, Texas due to Pink's health concerns. After Pink's death in 2002, Nova continued to live a full life in Andrews. She was a "Pink Lady" for many years at the local hospital, a very long time Avon representative, member of Calvary Baptist Church, a "designated driver" for her older lady friends, and a good neighbor and devoted friend to many.

Nova was preceded in death by her husband and elder son, Jimmy in 2003.

Nova is survived by her son, Otis "Odie" Bradley (Nancy) and daughter in law, Bobbie Bradley, grandchildren: Debbie Couch, David Bradley (Holli), Carol Layfield (Mac), Angie Hite (Marty) and Tony Bradley (Oma), 7 great-grandchildren and 7 great-great-grandchildren.

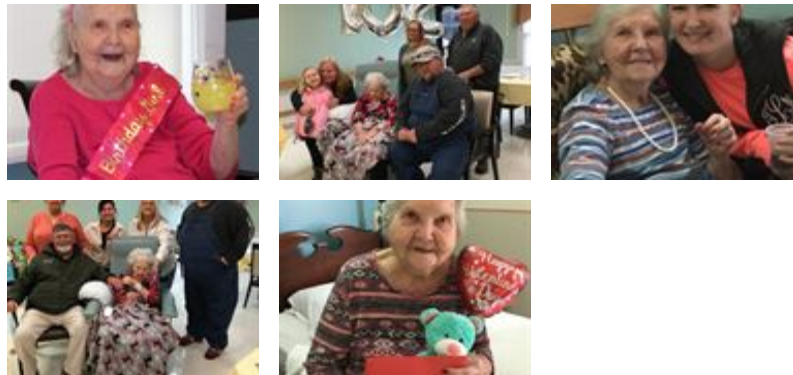
