



## Patricia Harvey

September 27, 1933 - March 13, 2022

Patricia Harvey, age 88, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 4:13 a.m., Sunday, March 13, 2022, at her home under the care of St. Anthony's Hospice.

Patricia was a master of many talents and accomplishments. Most notably, while living in Atlanta, she co-founded a nonprofit organization, 3 Keys, that provides shelter for the homeless mentally ill, whose honorary chair is Mrs. Rosalyn Carter, and that has grown to 479 units, covering several areas of the City. She was also an avid genealogist and a proud member of the DAR, tracing her family lines well into early English and Welsh history, and proving ancestry with the Emperor Charlamagne. Her hobbies and artistic talents were numerous.

In addition to her parents, Clarence and Hilda Powell, Patricia was preceded in death by her husband Robert L. Harvey. She is survived by her daughters Sara Jane Zinn of Henderson, KY and Mary Ann Barkerding (Harry) of Metairie, LA; and a grandson Harry Barkerding, Jr.
