Rev. Paul Harmon Royster, age 80, of Shelbyville, Kentucky formerly of Henderson, Kentucky passed away at 9:37 P.M. Tuesday, June 10, 2008 at Baptist Hospital East, Louisville, Kentucky.

He was born in Henderson, KY on June 17, 1927. He was the son of James Herman and Bessie May Royster. His first job was at Green River Nursery Apple Orchards in Robards, Kentucky from 1946-1947. He married on October 8, 1946 and had six children.

He graduated from Robards High School in 1945, Lindsey Wilson College in September of 1947, and attended Evansville College in Evansville, Indiana from 1948-1952 and the Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky from 1953-1954. He was the district manager for the State Department Revenue at Henderson and Ashland, Kentucky from 1957-1961. He was a minister at United Methodist Church. His first church assignment was in 1948. He ministered at Cave City Methodist Church, Cave City, KY, Allensville Methodist Church, Allensville, KY (June 1961-1962) Livermore Methodist Church, Livermore, KY (1962-1963) Sebree Methodist Church, Sebree, KY (1963-1965) Trinity Methodist, Covington, KY (1965-1969).

He was the Executive Director of the Housing Authority in Covington, KY (Dec. 1969-1971), City Manager, Covington, KY (1971-1976), City Manager , Frankfort, KY (1976-1990) and City Manager , Henderson, Kentucky in 1996. He owned and operated Deer Run Nursery Company in Bagdad, Kentucky and The Garden Path at Hawkheegan in Frankfort, KY.
