Ruth Gourieux Hazelwood, age 91, of Henderson, KY, passed away at 7:30 am Thursday, January 7, 2021 at the Lucy Smith King Care Center under the care of St. Anthony's Hospice, with her devoted family by her side. She was a very strong, loving wife, mother, mommaw, and friend. She will be sadly missed by all those who were blessed to have known her.

Ruth attended Murray State University where she met her beloved husband Anthony. They moved to Hebbardsville where she worked as an educator and later worked alongside with Anthony running Hazex Construction Company which started with one bulldozer in 1949. She also founded Temporary Structures, now known as Braco, Inc. She continued to manage both companies after Anthony retired in 1990. Ruth stayed active in the family business until her early eighties. She was a member of Henderson's First Baptist Church. She loved Henderson and she loved volunteering to make the world a better place. Ruth was active in various community activities including: Friends of Audubon State Park, Habitat for Humanity, The Fine Arts Center, and Riverview School. Ruth loved helping others be the best they could be and taught this lesson to her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, Joe and Ruth Gourieux, and her husband, Anthony Hazelwood.

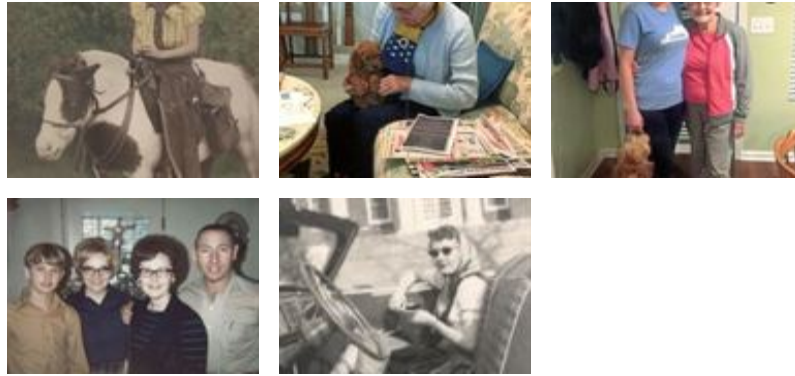
