Timothy was employed at Hydro Aluminum for 15 years since opening their company on Riverport Road. He was a Christian and attended First Baptist Church. During the last two years of his life while battling cancer he witnessed to many different people. He graduated from Union County High School where he was a Hall of Fame Inductee. He pitched for the Union County High School team and was talented enough to try out for the Kansas City Royals and the Mariners. He was a member of several teams that traveled around parts of the Midwest playing softball. His goal was accomplished when he won the Super National Softball Association World Series Championship. Each player received a World Championship ring. He was a member of Reds Boys from Covington, KY and Texas Roadhouse Team A Ball Division.
