Tracey Oliver Green, age 64, passed away Saturday, May 29, 2021, at Henderson Deaconess surrounded by her family. She battled the COVID-19 virus for 3 weeks before losing her fight.

Tracey was born on August 14, 1956 in Hopkinsville to Bobby Dale Oliver and Linda Mitchell Oliver. She moved to Henderson at the age of 7, where she lived for the rest of her life. She graduated in 1979 from Murray State University with a Bachelor's degree in Nursing. In 1981 she received her master's degree from the University of Evansville. Tracey worked at many of the local area hospitals, some of her fondest memories were working in the neonatal unit at St. Mary's Hospital. She was a nursing instructor at Henderson Community College, Kentucky Wesleyan and at Ivy Tech in Evansville. She pioneered the "Just Say No" program at the Henderson County Schools. She retired from the VA Clinic in Evansville in 2019 after helping countless veterans get the help they needed. Tracey was a devoted wife and mother. She loved going to her children and grandchildren's ballgames. She enjoyed going on family vacations, spending time with her pets, and going to the swimming pool.

She was preceded in death by her parents Bobby Dale and Linda Oliver. She is survived by her husband of 40 years Richard "Rick" Green of Henderson, KY; 3 daughters Tara E. (Green) Mullins, Kala Green, and Gabriella Green; 1 granddaughter Mila Mullins all of Henderson, KY. She leaves behind a lifetime of caring for her family, friends, and the Veteran's.
