Veronica Laverne Clement was born on August 30, 1947, in Madisonville, Kentucky to Cloyce Bradley Hicks and Connie Marie Hicks. She passed from this life on Tuesday, February 14, 2023, in Collinsville, Oklahoma at the age of 75 years.

Veronica was raised and educated in Madisonville and graduated with the Madisonville High School Class of 1965.
