Victor Brian Perry, age 55, passed away in his sleep on the morning of Sept. 18, 2013.

Vic was born in Ashland, KY and had resided in Henderson, KY for 37 years. He was a graduate of HCHS, and after attending college at WKU, he had a successful career in manufacturing maintenance with local companies Perma Industries, Kusan, and Aeroquip. Later he provided technical engineering support as a consultant to Siemens in Juarez, Mexico. After a series of successful investments including local properties, he retired from manufacturing and remained self-employed. Vic had a diverse range of talents including watercolor and oil painting, knowledge of hydraulic electrical systems and a mastery of conversational Spanish. His love for fishing and the outdoors brought him many hours of joy, fishing on the Green and Ohio Rivers, Glacier Lake Montana, and the Gulf Coast of Texas. 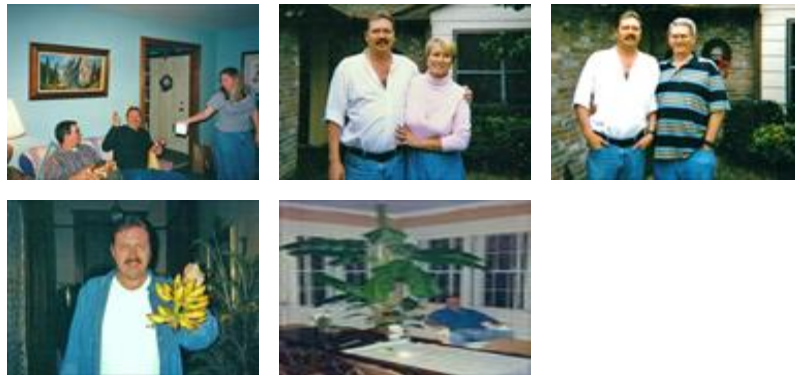
