Wilma B. Henry Glick, 103, passed peacefully in the early morning of November 3rd.

Born on February 5, 1919 in Vandalia, Illinois, she was raised by loving parents, Shella and

with her Pleasant Pointe family.

Wilma was a lover of holidays, traditions, and anything that meant spending time with family.

She frequently volunteered to babysit and enjoyed every second of it. She regularly visited her

family in Illinois. Even into her nineties, she would pack up the car with her dog Jobi and drive

herself for extended visits. She started many traditions that endure today and will be passed on

to generations to come. She loved cooking for others and sharing her recipes, which her family still uses today.

Wilma cherished her relationship with the Lord and was a lifelong member of Immanuel Baptist

Temple. Following the closing of IBT, she attended Chapel Hill United Methodist Church. Upon

her passing, it was revealed that notes and other keepsakes were tucked into her bible, forming

a scrapbook of her life.

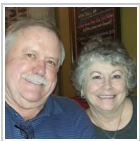
